1.6. REVIEW AND SUMMARY OF EXPECTED OUTCOMES - Date Reviewed: 10/12/2018

- 1.6.1. **OUTCOME 1 COMMENTS:** For the year, 78.2% of courses were registered for online. The Academic Success Center builds schedules for all first time freshmen for the fall semesters. This is why the fall numbers are lower than the spring and summer numbers. We will always build schedules for first time freshmen in the fall semesters. We will also always register students in contract courses in the summer. For this reason, we will never have 100%. I believe we have met this goal and I will be removing this goal next year.

This goal will never be 100% met because we have students who change their schedules during the drop/add period. We also register students into FALS 101 at the end of each semester when the FALS requirement has been met. In the summer, we register students for contract courses after the add/drop period. Our summer numbers went up because we no longer register students for LU 102 in the summer or LU 103 in the fall. I believe we have met this goal and I will be removing this goal next year.

We did not have a number of office-created verifications, so the denominator was unduplicated headcount for academic year. We have found that more students are needing these verifications before we submit the Clearinghouse reports. We are researching ways to improve this goal. In the Fall 2017 semester, we began submitting an extra enrollment report before the semester begins.

The Registrar's Office will also print transcripts for students who have completed an Academic Petition form and need to be reviewed by the University Petitions Committee.

This is for new students who applied to Lander in the Spring 2017 semester. We started using a program called TES (Transfer Evaluation System) from College Source in October 2015. Our number for the Spring 2015 semester was 84% so we had a 6.7% increase since that year.
 - 2.6.1.1. ADDITIONAL RESOURCES REQUIRED TO ACHIEVE OR SUSTAIN RESULTS FOR INDICATOR OF SUCCESS 1: We currently pay College Source \$4,322 every year to use the TES program.

- 2.6.4. Outcome 4 Comments: For the Fall 2017 semester, 83.6% of transfer work was posted within 1 month of receiving the college/university transcript. This number is for continuing students who were enrolled at Lander during the Fall 2017 semester. We started using a program called TES (Transfer Evaluation System) from College Source in October 2015. Our number for the Fall 2015 semester was 89% so our number decreased since that year. In Fall 2017, we reviewed 1,351 transcripts (new and continuing students combined). In Fall 2015, we reviewed 1,009 transcripts (new and continuing students combined). We reviewed 342 more transcripts in Fall 2017 than in Fall 2015. When reviewing transcripts in the fall, we try to review them based on the date we receive them. We also have Transfer Week, Freshmen Orientation week, and New Student Orientation. During those times we tend to review transcripts for new students since they are on campus and would like to have everything posted during that time for advisement.
